



Submission terms and conditions

By submitting an abstract to present at the RSA 2023 Conference, you agree to the following terms and conditions:

- Accepted authors must register and pay to attend the conference by 31 March 2023. Failure to register will result in the submission being withdrawn
- Paper submissions must be the original work of the submitting author(s).
- All submissions must meet the format requirements specified by the RSA.
- The RSA reserve the right to refuse material that does not meet requirements or is deemed inappropriate, in either content or size
- Required papers and documents must be submitted through the online presentation portal. Submissions will not be accepted any other way, including via email, in hard copy format or by fax.
- Submission acceptances will be advised in the week of 6 March 2023.
- For oral presentations, only one author will be allowed to present.
- The RSA reserve the right to publish all accepted abstracts via the conference program, website, app and/or other channels.
- You grant the RSA the right to publish a PDF of your slides. If you require modifications to your slides or do not want slides published the author/s of the presentation/submission papers are required to email the RSA at events@renalsociety.org and advise of the changes you would like to make.
- You grant RSA permission to live-stream the presentation and make this available for media, conference attendees, staff, sponsors, members and other RSA stakeholders.
- If you are accepted for a presentation or poster - the author's name, job title, organisation name, photo and biography will be included in the conference app.
- You retain ownership of all copyright you own in the Presentation that you disclose or present to the audience.
- We agree that we will only use your Presentation in accordance with these terms or as we otherwise mutually agree in writing.
- You consent to us:
 - recording your Presentation (including audio, video and presentation slides), to reproduce and/or upload that recording and materials
 - making that recording and materials available online for education purposes as part of our education Program for up to 5 years after the Date of Presentation.
 - using snapshots of your content for marketing purposes in print, social, and digital medias.

- You warrant that you are licensed to use all content that you disclose or use in the Presentation.
- You warrant that our recording, use and reproduction of content from the Presentation will not infringe on the intellectual property right of any person.
